We've had a busy summer in 2023. We kicked off June with a fun pork barbecue dinner hosted by the Yokefellows Sunday School class. We hosted a very successful Vacation Bible School in July. We also survived a vicious day of storms that did significant damage in our community, and our sanctuary roof was not spared. Hopefully, by the time this goes to press we will know exactly how we are moving forward on that. We also held a monthly fellowship time after worship on third Sundays this summer. As we look ahead to September, we have much going on, and I want to tell you about that.

On **Sunday, September 10,** we will highlight Christian Education during the education hour and during worship. This is always a special Sunday, as we give new Bibles to third graders and pray for our teachers, in addition to other activities. On **Sunday, September 17**, our worship will be "A Celebration of Faithfulness," with an emphasis on stewardship. If all of us when we are shopping, could grab snacks that are prepacked, like crackers, chips, cookies, lollipops, etc., we could keep our snack supply fully stocked.



Community Cup Coffee and More is located on Burke Street, and yes, it's a coffee shop. But it is also a ministry seeking to reach people in the recovery and other disenfranchised persons who do not feel comfortable in traditional churches. The new pastor, Dwight McCormick, will start his work next month. Unlike typical pastorates, there is no congregation or session, yet. Dwight and his wife will be staying in an AirBnB while they seek permanent housing. Please keep Dwight and Community Cup in your prayers. I am certain we will be doing some work together in the years to come.

I hope we are all able to make the most of the remaining days of summer. As busy as they have been, they have been a source of blessing for us. And those blessings are poised to continue as head into the fall season.
